Important Guidelines

- Recommended to arrive by 1:30 PM for registration and warm-up.
- The games will commence promptly at 2:30 PM.
- Please note that a maximum grace period of 10 minutes will be allowed for games participants. Any arrival beyond this time will result in disqualification.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct or disrespect towards referees will result in disqualification.
- Dress Code: Event jersey and proper sports shoes are mandatory.

Tournament Format: Knock-out format for 2 rounds then round robin and

• Basic Gameplay

- Padel is played in doubles (two players per team) on a court smaller than a tennis court, enclosed by walls.
- The game starts with a serve, which must be hit underhand and bounce in the opponent's service box.
- The ball must hit the ground before touching any part of the enclosure (walls or fence) on the serve.

• Scoring

- The scoring system is the same as tennis: points are counted as 15, 30, 40, and game.
- 1 set consisting of 6 games.
- Golden point if there is dues.

• Serving

- Serves must be hit underhand and bounce within the opponent's service box.
- The server has two attempts to get the serve in the correct service box.
- The serve must land in the diagonal service box across the net.

• Ball in Play

- After the serve, players can hit the ball after it bounces once on their side or directly hit it off the walls.
- The ball can hit the walls after it bounces on the ground, but must return to the opposing side of the net.
- Players can use the walls on their side of the court to return the ball over the net.

• Faults and Points - A point is lost if:

- The ball bounces twice on the ground before being returned.
- The ball hits the net and lands on the server's side.
- The ball hits the enclosure directly without bouncing on the ground first.
- The ball bounces outside the play area.
- A player hits the ball into the net.
- A player touches the net or the opposing side's court.

• Let and Replays

- A "let" is called when a served ball touches the net but lands in the correct service box, allowing for a re-serve.
- If any external interference affects the game, a let is called, and the point is replayed.
