

# **CRICKET RULES**

## **Match Format:**

- Overs: 8 overs per innings for the knockout 4 matches Remaining 3 matches 8
   Overs only.
- Ball: Hard-tennis ball (Tennex, Red Ball), a new ball for each innings.
- Knockout games
- Bowling Restrictions:
- 2 bowler can bowl a maximum of 2 overs

## Scoring:

## Runs:

- Runs are scored by running between the wickets.
- Boundaries:
- 4 runs for a ball crossing the boundary after touching the ground.
- 6 runs for a ball crossing the boundary without touching the ground.

## No-ball Runs:

- Any delivery above head height or a full toss above waist height.
- 1 runs awarded with extra delivery
- Runs from a batsman's shot off a no-ball also count.

### Wide Balls:

- 1 runs awarded with extra delivery
- Byes and Leg-byes:
- Bye: Runs scored when the ball passes the batsman without being hit.

Leg-bye: Runs scored when the ball hits the batsman (not the bat) and an attempt to play a shot is evident.



# **CRICKET RULES**

#### Dismissals:

- Bowled: The ball hits the stumps and dislodges at least one bail.
- Caught: The ball is caught on the full by any fielder after touching the bat or glove.
- Stumped: The wicketkeeper removes the bails while the batsman is out of the crease and not attempting a run.
- Run Out: A batsman is out if no part of his bat or body is grounded behind the crease when the stumps are fairly put down.
- Hit Wicket: A batsman is out if he hits his own stumps with his bat or body during the delivery stride.
- Handled the Ball: Out if the batsman deliberately handles the ball with the hand not holding the bat, without the opposition's consent.
- Timed Out: A new batsman must be ready to face the ball within 3 minutes of the previous dismissal.
- Hit the Ball Twice: Out if the ball is hit twice intentionally (unless protecting the stumps).
- Obstructing the Field: A batsman is out if he deliberately obstructs the fielding side.

### No-ball Rules:

### Reasons for No-ball:

- · Above head height.
- Full toss above waist height.
- Ball bouncing more than twice or rolling before reaching the batsman
- · Illegal fielder positioning.
- Penalty: 2 runs (1 run during the last over).
- The ball does need to be re-bowled during the last over.

## Fielding Restrictions:

A minimum of 2 fielders must always remain inside the fielding circle at all times.

#### Wide Ball Rules:

- Declared when the batsman has no reasonable opportunity to score off the delivery.
- Same penalty as no-ball (2 runs, except 1 run in the last over).
- The ball does need to be re-bowled during the last over.

### Important Notes:

- Umpire decisions are final.
- · Ensure sportsmanship and respect for the game at all times.
- If any rules are not explicitly mentioned in this document, ICC rules will apply.

# **FOOTBALL RULES**

## **Qualification -**

- The top 2 teams from each group will qualify for finals based on points, and goal difference
- Ranking will be determined based on Points.
- In case of teams finishing the league round with equal points, qualification will be decided based on goal difference.

## General Rules -

- A match consists of two 10-minute halves with a 1-minute rest period in between.
- Each team can have a minimum of 5 players (including 1 goalkeeper who is the only player allowed to handle the ball within the circle).
- Shoes shall be the flat or turf shoes only.
- Substitutions can be made at any time of the match with each team being able to make Rolling substitutions during a dead ball or at half-time.
- During the league fixtures, if the game is level at the end of the final whistle as a result both teams will get a point.
- Knockout stage, if the game is level at the end of the final whistle as a result both teams will get three penalty shots each.
- The whole ball must cross the goal line for it to constitute a goal.
- For fouls committed a player could receive either a yellow or red card depending on the severity of the foul; this comes down to the referee's discretion. The yellow is a warning and a red card is a dismissal of that player. Two yellow cards will equal one red. Once a player is sent off then they cannot be replaced.
- If a ball goes out of play off an opponent in either of the sidelines then it is given as a throw-in. If it goes out of play off an attacking player on the baseline then it is a goal kick. If it comes off a defending player it is a corner kick.

# **BADMINTON MEN'S RULES**

### Qualification:

• Top 2 teams from Each group will qualify for the Semi Finals

### **Scoring System:**

- Knockout and league matches consist of 1 set of 15 points.
- Semi Finals consist of 3 sets of 21 points.
- Finals consist of 3 sets of 21 points.
- Every time there is a serve, there will be a point scored, unless that point is replayed.

## **Doubles Play:**

- At the beginning of the game and when the score is even, the server serves from the right service court. When it is odd, the server serves from the left court.
- The server must hit the shuttle into the opposite service court. In doubles, this extends to the outside rectangular space.
- Once the shuttle is hit after a serve it may be returned to any portion of the other end of the court marked by the outside edges of the boundary lines.
- If the receiving side wins a rally, the receiving side scores a point. The receiving side becomes the new serving side.
- The players do not change their respective service courts until they win a point when their side is serving. After the serve is played by the receiving team, either partner may make a play on the shuttlecock during consecutive returns.

### Faults:

- If in serving, the shuttlecock is struck above the server's waist.
- If at the serve, the shuttlecock falls into the wrong receiving court.
- If the server's and receiver's feet are not within the boundaries of their serving and receiving court, respectively.
- If the partner of the receiver takes the serve.
- If a player touches the net with his/her racquet, person, or clothes.
- If the shuttlecock is struck in return before it has crossed the net to the side. (The follow-through may break the plane of the net.)

### General Rules:

- You should not serve until the opponent is ready, but if the player attempts to return the serve, he is considered ready and play continues.
- If you miss the shuttlecock while serving, you may serve again provided your racquet did not make any contact during the attempt.
- Birdies that hit the net as they cross during play are good and should be played.
- Birdies that fall on the line are considered good.

# **BADMINTON WOMEN'S RULES**

### Qualification:

• Top 2 teams will qualify for the Finals

### **Scoring System:**

- Knockout and league matches consist of 1 set of 15 points.
- Finals consist of 3 sets of 21 points.
- Every time there is a serve, there will be a point scored, unless that point is replayed.

## **Doubles Play:**

- At the beginning of the game and when the score is even, the server serves from the right service court. When it is odd, the server serves from the left court.
- The server must hit the shuttle into the opposite service court. In doubles, this extends to the outside rectangular space.
- Once the shuttle is hit after a serve it may be returned to any portion of the other end of the court marked by the outside edges of the boundary lines.
- If the receiving side wins a rally, the receiving side scores a point. The receiving side becomes the new serving side.
- The players do not change their respective service courts until they win a point when their side is serving. After the serve is played by the receiving team, either partner may make a play on the shuttlecock during consecutive returns.

#### Faults:

- · If in serving, the shuttlecock is struck above the server's waist.
- If at the serve, the shuttlecock falls into the wrong receiving court.
- If the server's and receiver's feet are not within the boundaries of their serving and receiving court, respectively.
- If the partner of the receiver takes the serve.
- If a player touches the net with his/her racquet, person, or clothes.
- If the shuttlecock is struck in return before it has crossed the net to the side. (The follow-through may break the plane of the net.)

### **General Rules:**

- You should not serve until the opponent is ready, but if the player attempts to return the serve, he is considered ready and play continues.
- If you miss the shuttlecock while serving, you may serve again provided your racquet did not make any contact during the attempt.
- Birdies that hit the net as they cross during play are good and should be played.
- Birdies that fall on the line are considered good.

# **VOLLEYBALL RULES**

## Qualification

- Top 2 teams will qualify for the Finals.
- · Ranking will be determined based on the following criteria:-
  - 1. Number of wins
  - 2. Higher sets difference
  - 3. Higher points difference

### The Serve:

- Server must serve from behind the end line until after contact
- Ball may be served underhand or overhand
- Ball must be clearly visible to opponents before serve
- Served ball may graze the net and drop to the other side for point
- First game serve is determined by a volley, each subsequent game shall be served by the previous game loser
- Serve must be returned by a bump only. no setting or attacking a serve

## Scoring:

- Rally scoring will be used.
- There will be a point scored on every score of the ball.
- Offense will score on a defense miss or out of bounds hit.
- Defense will score on an offensive miss, out of bounds hit, or serve into the net.
- League games will be played to 15 points of 1 set and Semi finals and Finals will be 25 points of 3 sets.
- If the teams are at 21 or 25 all, the team that wins the next point wins the set



# **VOLLEYBALL RULES**

## **Playing The Game:**

- Maximum of three hits per side
- Player may not hit the ball twice in succession (A block is not considered a hit)
- Ball may be played off the net during a volley and on serve
- A ball touching a boundary line is good
- A legal hit is contact with the ball by a player body above and including the waist which does not allow the ball to visibly come to a rest
- If two or more players contact the ball simultaneously, it is considered one play and the players involved may not participate in the next play
- A player must not block or attack a serve
- Switching positions will be allowed only between front line players. ( After the serve only
- Only 6 players per team at one time on the court
- Rolling substitutions

### **Basic Rule Violations:**

- Stepping on or over the line on a serve
- Failure to serve the ball over the net successfully
- Hitting the ball illegally (Carrying, Palming, Throwing, etc.)
- Touches the net with any part of the body while the ball is in play. If the ball is driven into the net with such force that it causes the net to contact an opposing player, no foul will be called, and the ball shall continue to be in play
- Reaching over the net, except under these conditions a) When executing a follow-through b) When blocking a ball that is in the opponent's court but is being returned (the blocker must not contact the ball until after the opponent who is attempting to return the ball makes contact). Except to block the third play
- Reaches under the net ( if it interferes with the ball or opposing player ) Failure to serve in the correct order
- Blocks or spikes from a position that is clearly not behind the 10-foot line while in a backrow position.
