

# **GENERAL EVENT RULES**

## 1. Eligibility:

### This event is strictly for employees of the participating corporates.

All participants must be on a company visa and must carry their company IDs with them at all times. HR representatives are responsible for verifying and ensuring compliance with this requirement.

### 2. Team Consistency & Player Substitutions:

Once the tournament begins, no changes or replacements to the team roster/fixture are allowed, even in cases of emergencies. The same set of players who participate in the first game must continue through to the finale. Substitutes, if any, must be declared before the tournament starts and cannot be swapped out once the first match is played.

### 3. Fair Play:

The decision of the referee/umpire is final.

Any disputes or disagreements will not be entertained once a decision is made.

Teams are expected to uphold the spirit of fair play and sportsmanship throughout the tournament.

### 4. Walkover Policy:

Teams must check in at the registration desk 30 minutes before their scheduled game.

If a team fails to arrive on the court within 5 minutes of the scheduled start time for any reason, it will be considered a walkover, and the opposing team will be declared the winner by default.

## 5. Equipment & Attire:

The players must wear their official tournament jerseys during the matches, failure to do so, will result in that player being disqualified from that match.

Players must use appropriate sports footwear and equipment to ensure safety on the court.

## 6. Conduct & Disciplinary Actions:

Any inappropriate behavior, misconduct, or violation of tournament rules will result in penalties, including potential disqualification.

The Fitze team reserves the right to enforce disciplinary actions to ensure a fair and enjoyable event for all participants.

### 7. Photography & Media:

Photos and videos will be taken during the event and will be used for Fitze's promotional purposes.























# **BADMINTON WOMENS RULES**

### Qualification:

- Top 2 teams from each group will qualify for the round of 32.
- · Ranking will be determined based on Points and Wins.
- In case of teams finishing the league round with equal points, qualification will be decided based on point difference.

### **Scoring System:**

- League and Knockout matches consist of 1 set of 21 points.
- Finals consist of 3 sets of 11 points.
- Every time there is a serve, there will be a point scored, unless that point is replayed.
- The first to reach 11 or 21 based on the game wins the game.

### **Doubles Play:**

- At the beginning of the game and when the score is even, the server serves from the right service court. When it is odd, the server serves from the left court.
- The server must hit the shuttle into the opposite service court. In doubles, this extends to the outside rectangular space.
- Once the shuttle is hit after a serve it may be returned to any portion of the other end of the court marked by the outside edges of the boundary lines.
- If the receiving side wins a rally, the receiving side scores a point. The receiving side becomes the new serving side.
- The players do not change their respective service courts until they win a point when their side is serving. After the serve is played by the receiving team, either partner may make a play on the shuttlecock during consecutive returns.

### Faults:

- If in serving, the shuttlecock is struck above the server's waist.
- If at the serve, the shuttlecock falls into the wrong receiving court.
- If the server's and receiver's feet are not within the boundaries of their serving and receiving court, respectively.
- If the partner of the receiver takes the serve.
- If a player touches the net with his/her racquet, person, or clothes.
- If the shuttlecock is struck in return before it has crossed the net to the side. (The follow-through may break the plane of the net.)

### **General Rules:**

- You should not serve until the opponent is ready, but if the player attempts to return the serve, he is considered ready and play continues.
- If you miss the shuttlecock while serving, you may serve again provided your racquet did not make any contact during the attempt.
- Birdies that hit the net as they cross during play are good and should be played.
- · Birdies that fall on the line are considered good.
